Welcome to Sweet Meadow Farm, a three generation family owned and operated business for the last 15 years! We pride ourselves on being an educational facility that specializes in raising and personally training all of our children-friendly animals.

Lessons are taught by Massachusetts certified instructors on safe horses, in the friendliest atmosphere!

Students participate in hands on learning with all of our farm and exotic animals such as a wallaby, miniature cows, miniature horses, goats, deer, emu, and all sorts of other small animals like baby bunnies and guinea pigs.

Advanced Barn Club focuses on the more technical aspect of riding, learning how to set up a jump course and fine tuning riding skills. Each Student receives an hour long riding lesson with a licensed instructor. After riding students help feed the horses their dinner and close up the barn for the night, allowing them to see the work that goes into owning and caring for a horse.
