



WAIVER OF LIABILITY

1. The student, parent and guardian of said student on their own and on their student's behalf, signify by signing this document that they understand that horses and the other animals of the animal science program, and swimming pools, can be dangerous and inherently risky, and carry the risk of causing injury, up to and including death. Nevertheless, with full understanding of the possibility and even the likelihood of injury or damage, the undersigned agrees to assume such risk and waive any and all claims for any injury or damage or any liability arising out of the student or parent or guardian's or their guest's participation in the program or programs offered by Patricia Michaud, Sweet Meadow Farm, or any other activity at 111 Coolidge Street, Sherborn MA. Further, the undersigned agrees to voluntarily release Patricia Michaud, Sweet Meadow Farm, and any of her or its employees, instructors, agents or assigns from any liability arising out of the student's participation on said properties, and further agrees to indemnify Patricia Michaud and Sweet Meadow Farm from any costs or damages brought that arise out of the student's participation in or entrance onto, any of the three listed properties. By signing this document, the student, their parents and guardians, signify that they have read this document fully, and understand its contents, and agree to undertake its provisions as part of the consideration of participation in or entrance onto, the listed properties and programs. This includes the inherent risk of horses and horse activities, and further includes the inherent risk that Patricia Michaud and/or her agents, employees, instructors, and assigns, may be ordinarily negligent in the provision of services.
